3) The Annual report by WCAA Chair Rebecca Freeman

Becky reported problems in U15 entries at the Inter-Counties' match. We would very much appreciate help with the website. The presentations for the WRRL went well

Becky's highlight was the performance of the U20 women at the Intercounties XC and WCAA's showing at the Fell Racing

The low point was the Inter Counties' Track and Field at Bedford where we had only 9 entries. The level of competition disappointed us. The event was held at the wrong time of the year. A discussion ensued during which the value of sending a team at all was questioned, entrants should perhaps make their own way there next time

The meeting concluded to propose to keep promotion of the Inter Counties low key and to only send self motivated athletes (not opposed)

Becky thanked all WCAA's officers. It had been a difficult year and she had enjoyed strong support from the committee. She will stand down at the 2014 AGM

Bill Adcocks added that UKA/EA should appreciate their volunteers more

Ray Morgan proposed acceptance of the Chair's report, Bill Adcocks seconded, this was not opposed

#### 4) The Financial report by WCAA Treasurer Jeremy Eastaugh

Jeremy reported that the Association's cash balance, £21,620, is £30 less than at the 2012 AGM. The balance was reduced by £3,530, £3,500 of this is right down of medals and vests stock

As usual income from the XC Championships was good with a £1,700 surplus. The Track and Field Championships earned us £500
