

Background: 2018 Balsall Common Fun Run was used as a trial event prior

to formal application

Research: Research amongst WRRL members who took part was

undertaken on the day and after the event

Overall feedback very positive and supportive of the event's

entry into the WRRL in 2019

Research results: 90% new to the event

80% would definitely take part in the event again, 20% might

90% would recommend to a friend, 10% might

100% would support an application for the event to become

part of the WRRL



Potential areas for improvement;

- Congestion on course, particularly on second lap
- Some difficulties with website
 - Finding race on main site
 - Minor issues with online entry
 - Finding results link
- Results not in age category
- Timing of event
- Registration process/opening times



Options under consideration/to be implemented;

- Start WRRL members 30/45minutes ahead of main fun run
- New event microsite will be used in 2019
 - Improved online entry system
 - Clear results link
- Age category results will be provided to the WRRL
- Event start will be 11:30am if WRRL members start ahead of main event
- Registration will 'officially' stay open until 30 minutes before race start
